

## **REALTORS® for Habitat Raise Funds at Second Annual Rummage Sale**

REALTORS® in Northeastern CT recently held their second annual rummage sale to benefit Habitat for Humanity of Northeast CT. Brad Favreau of Loomis Real Estate and Lynn Converse of Tedeschi Real Estate served as Co-Chairs of the group. Favreau and Converse oversaw the efforts of nearly two dozen local Realtors as they solicited from and picked donations up at clients' homes. The REALTORS® organized and sold an assortment of items from furniture, dishes, plants and clothing to homemade baked goods raising over \$3,000 for the local Habitat affiliate. The generous donation by Jay Sinha, a local business owner, of the use of a vacant commercial building for the rummage sale enabled the Realtors to collect, organize and sell the items out of one central location. At the conclusion of the sale Realtors for Habitat donated many unsold items to local citizens; select pieces of furniture went to the Habitat ReStore.

Accepting the donation for Habitat, long time Board member and Treasurer Lynn Brodeur said the money would go directly to the Habitat build currently underway in Brooklyn, CT. Brodeur, Senior Vice President of Putnam Bank said Habitat is presently clearing the property that will become home for the newest Habitat family; she also noted
